



Reflection Questions by Stage

1. Are you satisfied with the status quo? Too satisfied?
2. Does joining God and his mission in the world excite you? Why or why not? Do you want more out of life?
3. Can you point to a time when you have refused or been reluctant to respond to God's call to adventure? Why did you turn back?
4. Who or what has served to encouraged you to enter into the adventure? What was it in them (or it) that enabled you to cross the threshold?
5. What bolsters your faith in God? When have you embraced uncertainty and saw greater surrender to God to be the preferred option?
6. Do you recall a time when you realized that your gifts and abilities were the "superpower" God has given you to serve others? And also realized that you needed greater character to steward your gifts well.
7. When have you embraced trials, attack, and turmoil as the tools that God uses to shape your character? Are you willing to do the hard work of transformation?
8. How willing are you to risk it all for your own sake? How willing are you to risk it all for the sake of others? Which are you more prone to?
9. Can you recall a time when you have persevered and simply knew you were different, stronger, and ready for whatever was ahead?
10. Have you experienced transformation into greater Christlikeness? What were your feelings about engaging the "great threat to the world"? Excited...scared...both?
11. Have you ever experienced the sense of renewal or "resurrection"? Are you willing to offer yourself to an epic struggle with uncertain outcomes? If victorious, whom would you praise?
12. Can you imagine the sense of peace, purpose, and rest that would be characteristic of this stage? Do you believe God wants you to yearn for and experience this joy? Why or why not?
